Agency	California Air Pollution Control Officers Association (CAPCOA)
Purpose	Provides monetary grants to individuals, private companies and public agencies that clean up their heavy-duty engines more than required by air pollution regulations.
Program Status	Under development; Applications open on November 17, 2025
Due Date	Under development; the last solicitation was open for 1 month.

FUNDING ELIGIBILITY	
Eligible Entities	Public and private entities.
Eligible Vehicles or Station Types	Re-powering or retrofitting of existing engines and vehicles, as well as the purchase of new low-emission engines or vehicles. Eligible project types include off-road compression-ignition, off-road large spark-ignition equipment, on-road heavy duty truck, and stationary agricultural engine.
Eligible Fuels	CNG;LNG;Battery Electric;Plug-In Hybrid Electric;Propane;RNG;Hydrogen Fuel Cell;Hydrogen Internal Combustion
Eligible Gross Vehicle Weight	0.0 - 80000.0
Minimum Horsepower	None
Eligible Geographic Location	Rural Air Districts in California. See chart below.

FUNDING LIMITS	
Maximum Solicitation Funding	Under development; the last solicitation had \$400,000
Maximum Vehicle Funding	Up to \$100,000 of incremental costs
Maximum Equipment Funding	Up to \$100,000 of incremental costs
Maximum Infrastructure Funding	Not applicable
Maximum Applicant Funding	\$100,000
Maximum Project Funding	\$100,000
Stackability	Can be stacked with local, state, or federal funding, but will need to be a further discussion with CARB if there is additional funding awarded to this particular project.

PROJECT REQUIREMENTS	
Scrappage Requirement	Under development; Scrappage requirements vary depending on the type of equipment. The District will conduct a post-inspection.
Special Lease Provisions	Leasing is not allowed.
Operational Requirement	Operate the engine/vehicle within California for at least the percentage of time specified in the contract.
Public Access Requirement	Not applicable
Reporting Requirement	The District will require annual reporting from the Program Participant through the contract life.
Purchase Order Timing	Must not purchase prior to contract agreement.
Deployment Timing	Vehicles must be deployed as soon as possible. Districts will be in contact with the awarded project on the timeline.
